Field Archaeologist

Paleocultural Research Group, a nonprofit organization based in Broomfield, Colorado, anticipates hiring a full-time Field Archaeologist in spring 2018. We are seeking an experienced archaeologist who is passionate about research and public education. The job will involve a variety of activities, including planning projects, leading field crews, and teaching archaeological methods. The work will include a full schedule of summer fieldwork in the Plains and Rocky Mountains.

The position will be filled upon availability of grant and contract funds and will be three to four months in duration. Salary will be in the range of \$2,400 to \$2,900 per month depending on qualifications and experience. Fully qualified applicants will have at least one field season of experience as a crew chief. Prior experience in Plains and Rocky Mountains archaeology is preferred but not necessary.

For full consideration, applications should be submitted by **April 6, 2018**. The start date is negotiable but will be prior to the beginning of the 2018 field season. The end date also is negotiable depending on availability. If additional funding is available, the position may be extended beyond the field season.
