Research Archaeologist

Paleocultural Research Group, a nonprofit organization based in Broomfield, Colorado, anticipates hiring a full-time Research Archaeologist in spring 2018. We are seeking an experienced, creative archaeologist who is passionate about research and public education. The job will involve a diverse mix of challenging activities, including developing research designs, leading field investigations, teaching archaeological methods, analyzing artifacts, creating interpretive media, and giving public lectures. The work will include a full schedule of summer fieldwork in the Plains and Rocky Mountains, with analytic, creative, and writing work taking place in Broomfield.

The position will be filled upon availability of grant and contract funds and will be at least one year in duration. Salary will be in the range of \$3,500 to \$4,500 per month depending on qualifications and experience. Fully qualified applicants will have completed a Master's degree in anthropology (or related fields) and have 5 years of professional experience. Preference will be given to candidates with strong writing and supervisory skills. Prior experience in Plains and Rocky Mountains archaeology is preferred but not necessary. Also preferred is experience in GIS and database management.

For full consideration, applications should be submitted by **April 6, 2018**. The start date is negotiable but will be prior to the beginning of the 2018 field season.

Applicants should submit a letter of application that describes their experience and qualifications, a professional vita, a writing sample, and the names and contact information for three persons willing to write a letter of professional recommendation. Applicants are also encouraged to submit pertinent supporting materials that demonstrate their creative, analytic, writing, and communication skills and experience.
